Paolo Segatti is Professor of Political Sociology at the Università degli Studi di Milano, after having been professor at the University of Pavia, Venezia and Trieste. He was also repeated wising professor or fellow in several European and USA Universities, including Yale, Ohio, Mannheim and Autonoma de Madrid. He has been founder and, from 2009 to 2015, vice president and president of Italian National Election Study (Itanes). He received several national and EU grants His fields of scientific interest are comparative political behavior, public opinion and national vs European identity. He is currently working on an edited volume on Religion and Politics in Europe (with J.R. Montero and K. Calvo), a book on the consequences of context on voting and vote choice (with . H. Schmitt and C. van der Eijk) and a book on comparison between Germany and the four Southern EU democracies at the time of the Grand Recession (with J. van Deth and J.R. Montero).
